NOTICE OF MOTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the following motion to be moved at Convocation on May 26th, 2022:

WHEREAS:


1. Public Sector Salary Disclosure Act, 1996 (the "**Salary Disclosure Act**") makes Ontario's public sector more open and accountable to the public by requiring them to make public the names, positions, salaries and total taxable benefits of employees paid an amount exceeding the amount prescribed by the Salary Disclosure Act in the previous calendar year.
2. The Law Society is a regulator that regulates its members (licensees) in the public interest.
3. The members of the public, and the members of the Law Society whose fees allow the Law Society to operate in the public interest are entitled to more open and accountable disclosure of salaries paid by the Law Society.

THEREFORE, IT IS MOVED that Convocation


1. Direct its Chief Executive Officer to make a public salary disclosure no later than December 31st, 2022, and in each year thereafter, in the same manner as if the Law Society were a public body subject to the Salary Disclosure Act except that the Law Society shall disclose on or before December 31st, 2022, and annually thereafter
 - a. the number of employees whose salaries (including the cost of taxable benefits) exceed \$199,999.00 and are less than \$300,000.00; and
 - b. the names, positions, salaries and total taxable benefits of employees paid \$300,000 or more

in the previous calendar year
